Acting Presidents Report

WCF members,

I know that everyone is anxious to hear news about a new flying site. I wanted to provide everyone with an update about what the board has been doing to find a new site and how you can help.

During October and November here is what the board has been doing:

• Identifying potential sites and contacting landowners. As we find fields with potential, we have been looking up the landowner information for those sites and sending an inquiry to them. One especially interesting one is a large dairy that Kristin found on Llano road. It is listed as owned by Douglas Beretta, who Kristin sent a letter - if anyone knows the Beretta family, please let the board know.

• Posted a Craigslist ad. You can see our ad here, or go into Craigslist and search for "model airplanes" under the wanted section. No responses yet, but we will continue to run it.

• Keeping a list of potential sites. We have a spreadsheet of potential sites where we keep track of who and when we have contacted the landowners. We're trying to prevent confusion about who is approaching landowners.

• Updated the flyer. We revised it to focus on needing 2-4 acres of land and then additional agricultural land to fly over, we hope that this makes it easier to find a suitable property.

Here's what you can do to help:

• Send the board information about potential sites. At a minimum we need an address and short description, and if you know any information about the landowner that would be extremely helpful. Please send any info to <u>contact@wcflyers.com</u>

• Share the Craigslist ad on social media. Please consider a post with something like: Our model airplane club is looking to rent 2-4 acres of agricultural land in Sonoma County as a new flying site. If you know of any opportunities, please contact me and/or see the Craigslist ad below for more information.

• Talk to your friends and family. Send them the flyer, ask them if they have any ideas about places or people we should contact.

Colin's CL Shop

Well I finally completed my new Yak-9 CL model. I actually did a maiden flight last week at Napa. It flies better that I thought it would, and is fun to fly.

This model qualifies for Old Time Stunt competitions. To qualify for OTS, the model must have been designed, published or kitted prior to December 1952. The Yak-9 CL model was originally kitted by Sterling Models back in 1952. Brodak sells the kit today, but the new kit mimics the original Sterling design to maintain its OTS eligibility.

Stats:

40" wingspan 30.5 oz weight (no fuel load) Wing loading 13.5 oz/sqft OS 26 Surpass 4-stroke engine 2 oz uniflow fuel tank 9-7 APC sport prop (runs at 10,000 rpm) 10-15% nitro fuel (20% oil) Operable flaps Flown on 60' lines


